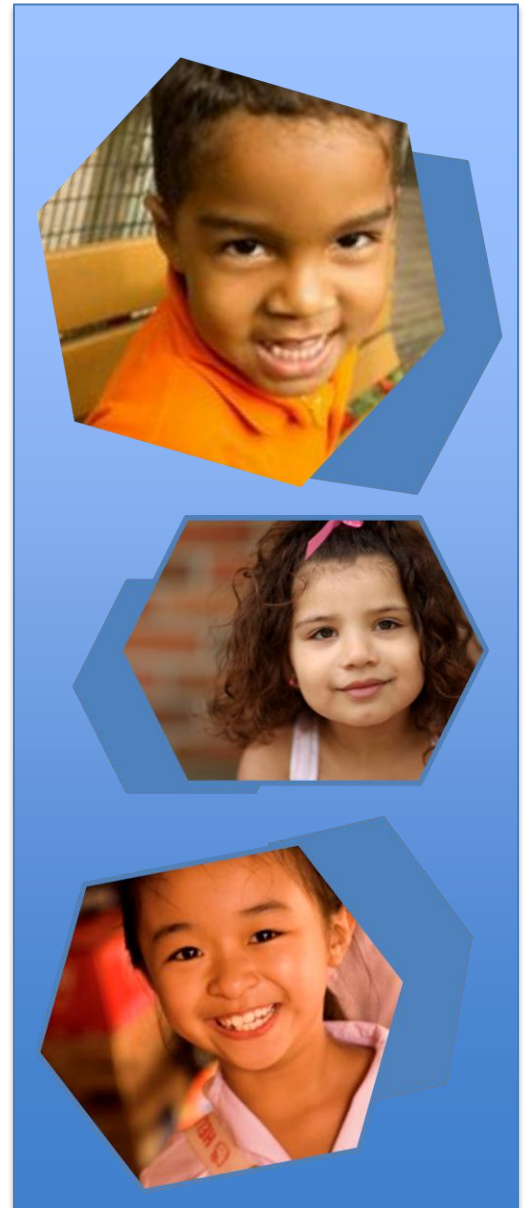

ISS-USA provides inter-country case management services on any case involving a child with family resources outside of the United States. ISS-USA offers a wide range of training options that can be modified for your staff's particular needs.

ISS-USA content specific trainings include, but are not limited to:

- International family finding and engagement
- Document tracings
- International home studies for visitation and/or custody
- Post-placement monitoring and reporting
- Child welfare checks in foreign countries
- Protective Service Alerts in foreign countries
- Utilizing technology to include family in permanency planning
- Travel assistance for social workers travelling to place a child
- Causes and factors of the separation of families across borders
- Developing policy and best practice for your agency on international child welfare issues



**TRAINING SERVICES:
