- Immigrant children in removal proceedings
- Unaccompanied minors wishing to voluntarily reunify with family in their home country
- U.S. citizen or foreign born children separated from parents after deportation
- Parentally Abducted Children
- U.S. citizen or foreign born child victims of trafficking

Adults Served by ISS

- Vulnerable adults at risk of physical, emotional or financial abuse.
- Vulnerable adults at risk of neglect or abandonment

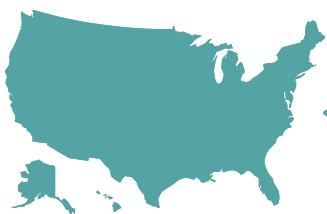
